Channel Catfish			6-8" \$1.75 each 6-8" \$70.00 Bag of 50	Compatible with all species, work well with Hybrid Sunfish and Bass.
Largemouth Bass			3" \$74.00 Bag of 50 5-8" \$180 Bag of 50	Popular game fish. Helps control Bluegill and crappie populations.
Fathead Minnows			2" \$10 per pound	Stock in new ponds prior to Largemouth Bass. Helps establish Food source for Bass.
Black Crappie			2-4" \$100 Bag of 100	Excellent to eat, and good sport fishing. Fish species help control insects.
Hybrid Bluegill			1-2" \$100 Bag of 250 3-5" \$65 Bag of 50	Fast growing, great for small pond will not overpopulate. (Hybrid sunfish)
Standard Bluegill			1-2" \$100 Bag of 250 3-5" \$65 Bag of 50	Prolific sport fish that should be stocked with Large-mouth Bass. Grow well on Plankton and insect forage produced by ponds. Fun to catch, good to eat.
Standard Redear			1-2" \$100 Bag 250	Rapid growth rate, low reproductive rate. Recommended for deeper ponds.
Triploid Grass Carp			10-14" \$13.00 each *permit by phone 217-762-2146 x101	Will not reproduce. They eat root aquatic vegetation, not algae. Good results following second season. *ponds must have an area that is 7-10 ft. deep for fish to over winter.
